Supports:

- -3-4 MDF or wood panels (minimum size 8 x 6 inches)
- -A few preferred surfaces for mixed media experimentation

Brushes:

An assortment of Filberts, Rounds, and Flats (sizes 0 through 12), with both Hog and Soft Bristles

An assortment of inexpensive 1-inch and larger brushes from a hardware store (for gessoing, mixed media collage, and staining)

Paints (Oil or Acrylic):

- -Titanium White
- -Permanent Alizarin Crimson
- -Yellow Ochre
- -Cadmium Yellow
- -Ultramarine Blue
- -Cadmium Orange
- -Viridian
- -Cadmium Red Light
- -Burnt Umber

Optional Colors:

- -Ivory Black
- -Cobalt Blue

For Oil Painters:

Gamsol and a jar with a lid (a basic kitchen jar will do)

Your preferred medium and a container for it

Your preferred palette

For Acrylic Painters:

Jars for water

Your preferred palette

Other Supplies:

Cotton rags or paper towels

Palette knives (various sizes and shapes)

Putty knife (plastic or metal)

Brayer

Newspaper

Gesso and matte medium

Sandpaper

Sketchbook paper
